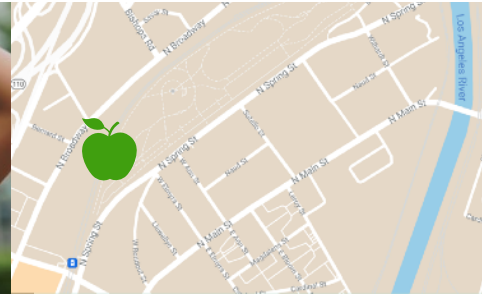




LA RIVER FARMERS' MARKET

- A weekly Certified Farmers' Market in the neighborhood will offer a reliable and sustainable source of delicious fruits, vegetables, and locally prepared food. It will also offer health and wellness resources to families.
- Equitable access to our market means amazing incentives for low-income families. The market will accept:
 - SNAP/EBT (food stamps)
 - WIC (a nutrition assistance program for Women, Infants, and Children)
 - Double EBT benefits through the federally funded Market Match program
- The market will boost economic development in the area for local businesses and will create new jobs. The market will generate a steady and sustainable revenue source for more than 20 regional farmers, local food entrepreneurs, and craft artisans.
- The park's 32 acres of beautiful open space is a safe gathering place for all ages and is easily accessible to all residents and visitors by foot, by bike, by bus, by train (steps from LA Metro's Chinatown Station), and by car (with plentiful parking options).
